

PLEASE BE CONSIDERATE

GENERATOR USAGE

Quiet Hours: 10:30 pm to 3:30 am.
No generator use during this time.

External generators must be at least 2 feet off the ground. Position generator exhaust away from neighboring guests. Generators louder than 80 decibels will be notified and will be asked to turn off. If not adhered to, you may be asked to leave with no refund.

PETS

Pets must be on leash outside RVs.

Please be considerate and clean up after your pet.

Be aware of loud noises such as balloon burners and fireworks.

Pets are not allowed inside Balloon Fiesta Park unless they are a service animal with proper designations.

BBQ GRILLS

Propane and pellet grills are allowed. **No charcoal grills.** Grills must be 2 feet off the ground.

Open flames, such as fire pits, are not allowed in any RV lot.

If you are using a grill for purposes other than cooking food, you may be asked to leave without a refund.



GENERAL INFORMATION

RV PARKING HOURS

Sept. 28 – Oct. 2: 8:00 am – 6:45 pm*
Oct. 3–9: 12:00 pm – 6:45 pm*

We strongly recommend arriving before 3 pm on days with two sessions (first weekend, Thurs.–Sat.) to avoid heavy traffic and potential check in delays.

There is no parking after 7:00 pm.

Late arrivals will be staged overnight and parked the next day.

**those in line at 6:45 will be checked in until 7*

Morning Check Out: 10:00 – 11:30 am

PARKING

An RV volunteer will direct you and assist with parking. All parking, with the exception of President's Compound, is rally-style (first come, first served).

- Once you are parked, the RV must remain parked until check out. All parking is at the discretion of AIBF and RV volunteers.
- Holding space(s) for other guests is not allowed. If you want to park together, arrive together.
- Each RV space receives one tow/towed placard. Up to two additional placards can be purchased at the check in booth for \$30 each. Place your RV parking placard so it is visible.
- AIBF reserves the right to ask you to move your RV/tow at any time.

MOTORIZED ALTERNATIVE TRANSPORTATION

The speed limit is 5 mph in all lots.

Loud motorized vehicles are prohibited. Golf carts and ATVs are not allowed for personal use.

Scooters are available for rent at the north and south guest gates.

CAMPFIRES

No campfires or propane fire pits allowed per Albuquerque Fire Rescue. Anyone caught burning a campfire of any sort will be removed from the RV lot without a refund.

TENT CAMPING

Tents, including tent camping, are not allowed in RV lots.

ELECTRIC WATER HEATERS

Electric water heaters are allowed only in President's Compound. Please use propane water heaters in all other lots.

FIRE LANES

Fire lanes are marked between rows and must remain clear during the event. **Do not block fire lanes.** Vehicles blocking fire lanes will be towed.

SMOKING

No smoking in any of the RV lots per the City of Albuquerque and the Fire Marshall's Office.

TRASH

Please keep your RV site clean. Place trash in the designated receptacles.

POTABLE WATER / PUMPING

Potable water fills and pumping services are conducted by AAA Pumping Service. Passes can be purchased at the check in tent in each lot. AAA services each lot daily, times vary based on needs.

Cost:

- Water Fills: \$40 each
- Waste Pumping: \$40 each

Absolutely no dumping of gray or black water on the ground.

PORTABLE TOILETS / RESTROOMS

Available at various locations in each RV lot. Please leave all supplies for other guests to enjoy.

TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

Transportation is FREE for guests in the South RV lot. Look for the "Shuttle Stop" signs or flags. Handicap transportation accommodations are available.

GENERAL ADMISSION TICKETS

An admission ticket is required for entry into Balloon Fiesta Park for each session. Tickets can be purchased online, at the Balloon Fiesta Gift Shop (4401 Alameda Blvd. at the corner of Alameda and Balloon Museum Drive) or at the park entrance gates.

- Presidents Compound guests receive 4 general admission tickets per session per day
- VIP East, West, and North guests receive 2 general admission tickets per session per day
- Box View and Standard guests do not receive general admission tickets

SESSION CANCELLATIONS

Balloon Fiesta is a weather dependent event. AIBF assumes no responsibility for session cancellations due to weather or safety concerns.

DRONES

Balloon Fiesta is a no drone zone.

Drones or other flying aircraft are not allowed in any of the RV lots.
